This office has received and reviewed your designation of successor unit operator in which your company has agreed to assume all rights, duties, and obligations as the unit operator of the Langlie Jal Unit Eddy County, New Mexico.

As your company as Resaca Operating Company has obtained a Nationwide 25,000.00 BLM Bond (NMB000624), a recommendation has been sent to BLM New Mexico State Office to require that Linn Operating, Inc. to post an additional individual Unit bond in the amount of \$150,000.00. The Authorized Officer condition of approval is based upon Resaca Operating Company final bonding to be in place within 60 days of the date of this letter.

Therefore, Resaca Operating Company is hereby approved as the unit operator for the Langlie Jal Unit as of this date and is effective April 1, 2011. In accordance with this approval, Resaca Operating Company is responsible for all operations and the reporting of all production from the unit. THIS INDENTURE, dated as of the 1st of February, 2012, effective the 1st day of April, 2011, by and between Resaca Operating Company, whose address is 1331 Lamar, Suite 1450 Houston, Texas 77010, hereinafter designated as "First Party", the Owners of the Unitized Working Interests, Resaca Exploitation, Inc. whose address is 1331 Lamar Suite 1450 Houston, Texas 77010, hereinafter designated as "Second Party".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, under the provision of the Act of February 25, 1920, 41 Stat. 437, 30 U.S.C. Secs. 181, et seq., as amended by the Act of August 8, 1946, 60 Stat. 950, the Secretary of the Interior, on the 4th day of January, 1971, approved a Unit Agreement for the Langlie Jal Unit Area, and

WHEREAS, Ranger 40 Petroleum has resigned as Unit Operator and the designation of another Unit Operator is now required pursuant to the terms thereof; and
