RECLAMATION PLAN

We will reclaim and recontour the location to a contour that approximates the original contour and blends with the surrounding topography and re-vegetate according to our Re-vegetation Plan.

☒ Soil Backfill and Cover Design Specifications

The soil cover will consist of the background thickness of topsoil or one foot of suitable material to establish vegetation at the site, whichever is greater. We will construct the soil cover to the site's existing grade to prevent ponding of water and erosion of the cover material.

☒ Re-vegetation Plan

In accordance with BLM's Reclamation Requirements, we will spread the stockpile of topsoil over the site to cultivate a seed bed. We will use BLM's Desired Plant Community seed mixture which has been determined by the Roswell Field Office for this geographic area. The seed mixture shall be evenly and uniformly planted over the disturbed area. We will apply no less than 8 pounds per acre. The reclaimed area will be seeded within BLM's recommended time period which is from June 15th through September 15th.

We will notify the division when the area has been seeded or planted and will repeat seeding or planting until the pit has successfully achieve the required vegetative cover.
