- 1. Operator did not submit a Subsequent Report sundry to describe the work approved on June 6, 2005, which included cement squeeze for casing leak, additional perforations, etc. Submit sundry with all details of work performed no later than April 30, 2012.
- 2. Submit replacement sundry by April 30, 2012. Replacement sundry to include before and after well bore schematics.
