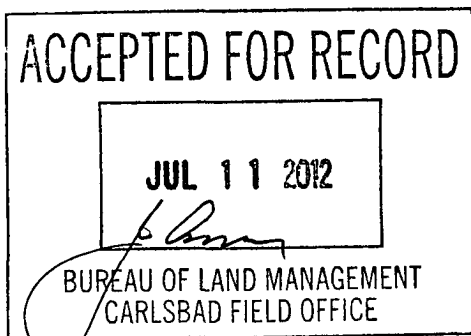

Gentlemen,

A field inspection was conducted on July 9, 2012 to determine reclamation objectives for the above referenced well location. Findings are as follows:

- 1.) Remove visible contaminants from the location.
- 2.) Flip the caliche from the location onto the old reserve pit encapsulating the barren, salt impacted portion of the pit. The cap on the pit is to be adequate to keep the salts from leaching back to surface.
- 3.) Any remaining caliche from the location and access road can be used for road repair or other projects.
- 4.) If adequate topsoil is not present after the caliche is removed you will need to reestablish the natural soils (or as close as possible).
- 5.) Contour the access road, location and the reserve pit area to blend with the surrounding landscape.
6. Disk and reseed all disturbed areas with the landowners preferred seed mix. In the absence of a preferred mix, utilize a combination of BLM seed mixture #1 and #3.
- 7.) Place a barricade across the entrance as close to the main access as possible.
- 8.) Remove any and all trash and debris that may be on or around the location.
