3. Trac tanks and number of traps can vary with daily operations and feed composition.

Operation and Maintenance Plan

1. All received fluids and solids will be discharged into reverse tank.
2. Reverse tank should not be pushed out into a big danger area because it will be overfilled.
3. Registry will visually inspect fluid intensity of reverse tank and trac tanks on a daily basis.
4. Concentration removal inspection of reverse tank and trac tanks will be captured on daily basis and will form report.

Disposal Plan

1. All received fluids and solids will be removed from reverse tank and be sent to site.
2. All received fluids and solids will be disposed of on a daily basis off the site. Local disposal facility.
