

## Closure Summary

Pursuant to Pit and Below-Grade Tank Guidelines as published November 1, 2004 by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.

Allstate Environmental Services was contracted by Mack Energy Corp. to commence closure activities of the drilling pits at the Fox Federal #9 lease in Lea County on April 12, 2005. As described in the Form C-103 for the Fox Federal #9, the fluids in the pit were removed and disposed of. The contents were then stiffened and buried per option IV.B.3.(b) of the Pit and Below-Grade Tank Guidelines. Closure of the pits was completed May 10, 2005.
