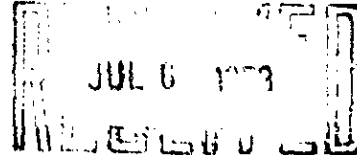

Dear Sir:

There is attached one copy of Notice of Intention to Drill, Form C-101, on this corporation's SFPRR Well No. 1-19, located 660' from the south and east lines of Section 19, T 9 S, R 36 E, Lea County. This copy is being sent direct to you, with three copies to Mr. Roy Yarbrough at Hobbs, because this corporation has only recently been qualified in New Mexico and has not yet filed a bond with you. The proposed well offsets a recently completed producer, and we are anxious to start it as soon as all necessary arrangements can be made.

Our duly qualified officers have executed a \$10,000.00 Blanket Bond, Form 39-A1, and it is today being executed by a Chicago representative of the Indemnity Insurance Company of North America as Surety. The bond will then be sent to Albuquerque to be countersigned by the New Mexico Resident Agent of the Indemnity Insurance Company of North America, who will deliver it to our Mr. E. C. Iden, who will in turn deliver it to you. We estimate that the bond should be in your hands early next week.

Since we are moving forward on securing the bond, and since it will be in your hands before we are able to let a drilling contract and commence actual operations on the drilling of a well, it is respectfully requested that you approve the Notice of Intention to Drill on our SFPRR Well No. 1-19.
