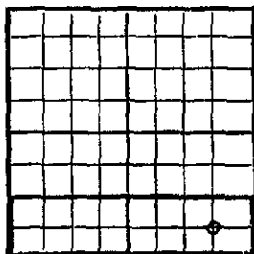

The status of a bond for this well in conformance with Rule 101 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Commission is as follows: Bond being secured from Indemnity Insurance Company of North America. It will be filed with Commission next week. We propose to use the following string of casing and to land or cement them as indicated:
