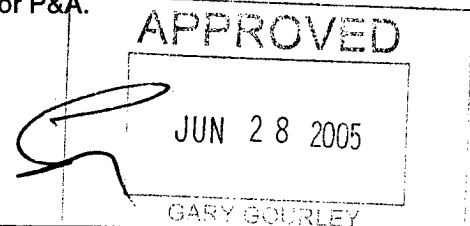
13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operation (clearly state all pertinent details, including estimated starting date of any proposed work and approximate duration thereof. If the proposal is to deepen directionally or recompletable horizontally, give subsurface locations measured and true vertical depths of all pertinent markers and zones. Subject well is uneconomic to produce. ConocoPhillips wishes to pull the pump and temporarily abandon well with an RBP. RBP setting depth will be in the vertical section above the curved section of the horizontal @ +/- 7675'.

Plans are to look at either squeezing-off water production with cement or polymer in order to return well to production within existing McKee zone, or recompletable the well uphole.

Per telephone conversation with Gary Gourley 06/23/05, request "verbal" 6 months approval for temporary abandonment, through 12/31/05, in order to complete evaluation to recompletable, reactivate, or P&A.
