On January 29, 2004, Bureau of Land Management (BLM) completed a field examination of the abandoned Meyer B-4 #25 located 2180 FSL & 1980 FWL in Section 4, T. 21 S., R 36 E., Lea County, New Mexico.

All final abandonment requirements have been met except for vegetative growth (20%) established evenly across the location.
