DETAILS OF WORK

The Hawk B-6 No. 1 ceased producing oil on 2-1-60 and was reclassified as a gas well and is presently shut-in.

We propose to pull 2" tbg, run depthometer to check TD, PB to 3565' with 1-1/3 yards of sand and gravel using a glass bottom bailer, dump 1.5 sx cement w/bailer to PB to 3550', perforate interval 3529-45' w/4 bullets per foot, run 2-1/2" test tubing w/pkr, set pkr above 3529', sandfrac w/10,000 gals of lease crude, 15,000 lbs sand and 500 lbs "Adomite", shut-in overnight, swab load and test well, pull 2-1/2" tbg, run 2" tbg, swab off and place well on production.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
