Based on the revised plugging program submitted by Agave on 7/15/12 and accepted by OCD for the record pending approval from the NMOCC, Agave completed the plugging of the well beginning Thursday November 15, 2012 and ending Wednesday November 20, 2012. The NMOCC heard Agave's request in a hearing on October 25, 2012 and the NMOCC approved the revised plugging of the Govt #2 per the revised plugging program submitted on 7/15/12. The well was reentered by removing the night cap on 11/16 and the well showed no pressure. The plugging effort involved the setting of plugs at approved depths with heavy salt gel mud between the cement plugs. Plugs were set at the following depths: 2535'-2310' (320sx), 1300'-1063' (290sx), 650'-525' (120sx) and 224' to surface (160sx). A diagram showing the plugging configuration is attached.


