Good morning Paul,

I have an approved APD for the Ophelia 27 #2H (180672) that is currently permitted as a Bone Spring Shale well. We are changing the target for this location to be a Wolfcamp test.

So to avoid confusion, I am about to submit a new permit for the same location with a new well number (701H) , 700 series for our Wolfcamp wells.

My question: the original #2H may be drilled but with a new location. Is it better for you for us to cancel the existing #2H and refile a new permit later or keep the existing #2H and amend later with a C-103 ? How is the cleanest way for you ?
