Operator has also failed to submit the required sundry notices for drilling operations. OPERATOR SHOULD IMMEDIATELY SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING: 1) SEPARATE C103's CONTAINING INFORMATION ON EACH STRING OF CASING, CEMENTING, AND PLUGGING. 2) A C105, 3) A DIRECTION SURVEY, AND 4) A COPY OF ANY LOGS THAT WERE RUN.1ST NOTICE. |                  |               |            |                              |                           |                |


