On October 27, 2008, the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) completed a field examination of the referenced abandoned well. All final abandonment requirements have been met except for vegetative growth (20%) established evenly across the location, and the removal of the power poles associated with this location. The BLM will continue to monitor the surface restoration of the referenced well location. All final abandonment requirements will have been met when the BLM is confident that the disturbed surfaces are capable of being restored to a condition similar to their original state.
