SITE PROTECTION AND EMPLOYEE EDUCATION: All employees of the project and subcontractors shall be informed that cultural sites are to be avoided by all personnel, personal vehicles and company equipment. They shall also be notified that it is illegal to collect, damage or disturb cultural resources.

 Monitoring is required. NO

- 1. A copy of these stipulations shall be supplied to the archaeological monitor at least five (5) working days prior to the start of construction activities.
- 2. No construction activities, including vegetation removal, may begin before the arrival of the NO archaeological monitor.
- 3. The archaeological monitor will: NO
 - a. Ensure that the site protection barrier is located as indicated on the attached map.
 - b. Observe all disturbing activities within _ feet of cultural site (see attached map).
 - c. Other:
 - d. Submit a report of the monitoring activities within thirty (30) days of completion of monitoring unless other arrangements are made with the BLM. These stipulations must be attached to the report.
- B. The grantee must select one of the following alternatives: NO
 - 1. Controlled test excavations to determine if cultural resources are present;
 - 2. Reduction of the project size to avoid all significant cultural materials;
 - 3. Relocation of the project;
 - 4. Preparation and implementation of a data recovery plan for cultural sites(s)
- C. SITE BARRIER/FENCING: NO
 - 1. A temporary site protection barrier(s) shall be erected prior to construction. The barrier(s) shall, at a minimum, consist of upright wooden survey lath spaced no more than ten (10) feet apart and marked with blue ribbon flagging or blue paint. There shall be no construction activities or vehicular traffic past the barrier(s). The barrier(s) shall remain in place through reclamation and reseeding.
 - 2. A permanent fence shall be erected prior to construction. There shall be no construction activities or vehicle traffic past the fence. An archaeologist shall monitor the construction of the fence.
 - 3. The barrier/fence shall be placed as indicated on the attached map.
- D. CONSTRUCTION ZONES: There shall be a no construction zone/staging area outside the previously disturbed area created by the construction of the original well location. LA 68290 is YES situated immediately southeast of the existing pad and is considered eligible for nomination to the National Register of Historic Places under criterion d.
- E. OTHER: Prior to construction at the alternative location for the Tres Elo Federal Com #2 the applicant shall remove the existing laths/stakes denoting the original location for the gas well. No YES additional land disturbance is allowed outside the existing well pad without having a cultural clearance inventory for the proposed action.
