XTO Energy Inc. received a "NOTICE OF VIOLATION AND SHUT-IN DIRECTIVE" on October 17, 2005 regarding the following well:

LEA COUNTY

*Shut in until 3/15/06
Well must stay shut in. CW*

Repair of this Injector and Return to Production was begun on November 11, 2005. From that date to December 6, 2005, attempts were made to isolate the leaks in the casing and repair. However this effort has been without success.

An AFE to run a liner has been issued to complete this well. This requires partner approval and may take some time. Attached is a copy of the Morning Reports on this well to date.

XTO Energy requests an extension to continue with this work over, to put in a liner and return well to injection as soon as all requirements are obtained.
