

Dear Ms. Aduddell:

Pursuant to that certain Surface Use Agreement and Release, dated January 16, 2007, Cimarex agreed that "all pits will be backfilled, levelled, and re-seeded with native grass as soon as reasonably practical, and all areas not requires for production operations will be returned to Grantors and restored as near as reasonably possible to its original condition." The Addudle No. 1 Well, API # 30-025-30407, was plug and abandoned October 10, 2015. This letter will serve as an agreement between Cimarex Energy Co. and Jack E. Aduddell and Irma Lee Aduddell (Grantors) to return the well pad site to Jack E. Aduddell and Irma Lee Aduddell, per their request, without further reclamation work done including re-seeding with native grass and restoring the location as near as reasonably possible to its original condition. The location is being returned in an "as is" condition and meets the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division requirements for the plug and abandonment of formerly producing oil and gas wells. By signing this agreement, Jack E Aduddell and Irma Lee Aduddell hereby release, discharge, indemnify and agree to hold Cimarex Energy Co., its co-owners, their employees, agents, contractors, sub-contractors, successors and assigns harmless from and against any and all claims, demands and liability with regards to restoration and reclamation of the Aduddle No. 1 Well pad site.
