Based on the chloride Levels inside the firewall area, Cross Border Resources propose to build a new SWD battery with the two existing 300 bbl fiberglass tanks. The battery will be built on the existing location pad for the Wattam Federal #6

Cross Border Resources plans to use 30 millimeter plastic inside the new firewall. This same plastic will actually go over the top of firewall. The edge of the plastic will then be held in place with caliche and native earth. The SWD battery will be the same dimensions as the original tank battery. Cross Border proposes to orient the new battery in a North-South configuration versus the original East-West configuration (See attached Google Earth image).

Once the two 300 bbl tanks are set on the new plastic lined firewalled battery, Cross Border proposes to dig down 4' and remove the contaminated soil inside the old firewall area. Cross Border will once again use Gandy Marley located in Roswell, New Mexico for the designated registered land farm. New soil will be brought in and the 4' hole will be filled. Ultimately, the soil will be seeded with native grasses. Cross Border Resources has been informed by the NMOCD that 4' depth is typical depth to insure the native grasses can thrive without issues of chlorides.
