For your information we responded to a tank battery fire on Monday (07/12/10) morning. The site was a Chesapeake Energy site. The sign on the battery was labeled

Bob White Federal #1 (Bone)
2355' FSL & 400' FWL
NW/4 NW/4 SW/4 Section 4-19S-34E
BLM #NMNM9414 API #3002532963
CA #100% BLM Lease 80 acres
Lea County, NM

The GPS coordinates are 32.68821 deg N and 103.57289 deg W. We made access from Hercules Rd (south, between mile markers 20 & 21 on St Hwy 529).

The fire appeared to be caused by lightning and was contained to the berm surrounding the three tank and Chesapeake had a crew on the scene to begin the rebuilding process before the fire units had even left.
