Basin Environmental Service Technologies, LLC (Basin), would like to thank you for the opportunity to present Marshall & Winston with this job summary at the Crossroads State 22-3H Tank Battery and well Pad site. The legal description of the site is as follows:

**Crossroads State 22-3H
Lea County, New Mexico
Section 22, Township 09 South, Range 33 East
Latitude 32.5251 North, Longitude -103.5574 West**

Basin has completed reclamation activities for the aforementioned site. These activities included removal of pad and entrance road (approximately 3,500 yd³) as well as removal of approximately 60 yd³ of material from around the wellhead that was disposed of at Gandy Marley Inc. All pad and road material was placed at the adjacent location and stockpiled. The fencing was removed as well as the gate. The fence was reconstructed at the highway to prevent access. The pad and road was then seeded with the preferred seed mix of the rancher, gramma grass, with NMSLO approved seed mix.
