Since production has declined to approximately 1/2 barrel of oil during the past six months, it is our intention to retrieve the uncemented casing and permanently abandon the subject well in accordance with existing New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission regulations.

The following casing strings are in the hole at the present time:

13" csg. 40# @ 303' cemented with 200 sx. in 17-1/4" hole.  
9-5/8" csg. 36# @ 1348' cemented with 500 sx. in 12" hole.  
7" csg. 22# @ 3516' cemented with 300 sx. in 8-3/4" hole.

An attempt will be made to recover the uncemented portion

20 sacks cement plug	3605-3505'
20 sacks cement plug in 7" stub (estimated)	1400-1500'
20 sacks cement plug	At Surface

A heavy mud laden fluid will be mixed and placed between all cement plugs. The location will be cleared and a 4" marker will be erected to extend 5 feet above the ground level.
