DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 4 PM November 25, 1937, 72 hours had elapsed, at which time we tested 9-5/8" OD new casing set at 1376 and cemented with 500 sacks.

We conducted the test in the following manner: built up 1000# pressure, closed valves and held for 30 minutes. Tested okay, drilled plug, built up 1000# pressure, closed valves and held for 30 minutes.
