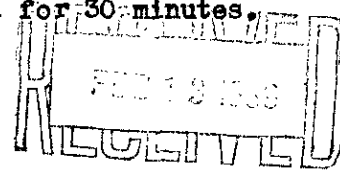

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 8:00 this morning 48 hours had elapsed since setting the 13" OD casing at 298' and cemented with 200 sax. At this time the shut-off was tested as follows:

Pressure was built up to 1000#, valves closed and pressure held for 30 minutes. Plug was then drilled and pressure again built up to 1000# and held for 30 minutes. Both tests were Ok and drilling was resumed.
