

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

At 8:00 AM February 10th 48 hours will have elapsed since setting 298 13" OD SH casing at 298' and cemented with 200 sax. At this time we plan to test casing shut-off in the following manner:

Build up 1000# pressure, close valves and hold for 30 minutes. Drill plug and again build up 1000# pressure to hold for 30 minutes. If tests are okay, drilling will be resumed.
