DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 1:30 A.M. November 5th, 72 hours had elapsed since setting 8-5/8" casing at 1379' with 500 sacks cement. At this time we tested shutoff in the following manner:

Built up pressure to 1000#, closed valves and held for 30 minutes. Drilled plug, again built up pressure to 1000#, closed valves and held for 30 minutes. Test was OK and drilling was resumed.
