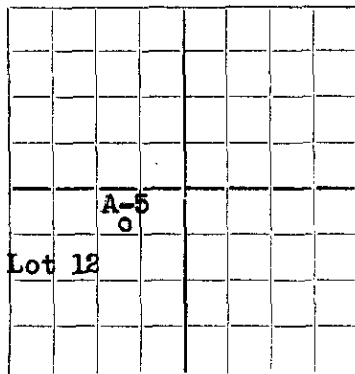

We propose to drill well with drilling equipment as follows: Rotary tools

to approximately 3550', and complete with cable tools.

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 3650 feet.

Additional information: We propose to drill with the above methods and casing program to a depth of approximately 3800' unless oil or gas in commercial quantity is encountered at a lesser depth. All work to conform to approved practice and in conformance with regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico.
