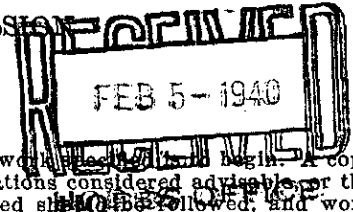

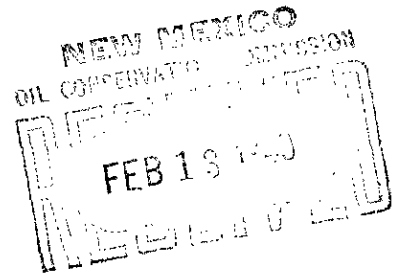

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

At 6:30 A.M., February 5, 48 hours will have elapsed since setting 13" casing at 271' with 180 sacks cement. At this time we propose to test shutoff as follows:

Bail hole dry and let stand for one hour. Drill plug, again bail hole dry and let stand one hour. If test is OK, drilling will be resumed.
