DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 1:30 AM, August 28th, 1941, 72 hours had elapsed since setting 8-5/8" casing at 1370' and cementing with 550 sacks of cement on the above location. At that time, we tested casing in the following manner:

Built up 1000# pressure and held for 30 minutes. Test was okay; drilled plug; again built up 1000# pressure and held for 30 minutes. This test was okay, too; drilling was resumed.
