Please be aware that this APD is within Lesser Prairie Chicken habitat and as a result of the settlement in a lawsuit between BLM and the litigant, we will be unable to approve any requests for exceptions without further environmental analysis which could take up to 30 days. Consequently, it is advisable to schedule drilling within Lesser Prairie Chicken habitat outside the March 15th to June 15th timing restrictions in order to avoid a delay if a request for an exception becomes necessary.
