CULTURAL RESOURCES STIPULATIONS CARLSBAD FIELD OFFICE

PROJECT NAME: Bass Poker Lake Unit #201

SITE PROTECTION AND EMPLOYEE EDUCATION: All employees of the project shall be informed that cultural sites are to be avoided by all personnel, personal vehicles and company equipment. They shall also be notified that it is illegal to collect, damage or disturb cultural resources.

- YES A. Monitoring is required.
 - <u>YES</u> 1. A copy of these stipulations shall be supplied to the archaeological monitor at least two (2) working days prior to the start of construction activities.
 - <u>YES</u> 2. No construction activities, including vegetation removal, may begin before the arrival of the archaeological monitor.
 - YES 3. The archaeological monitor will:
 - <u>YES</u> a. Ensure that the site protection barrier is located as indicated on the attached map.
 - <u>YES</u> b. Observe all surface disturbing activities during initial well pad and pit construction only.
 - NO c. Other:
 - <u>YES</u> d. Submit a report of the monitoring activities within thirty (30) days of completion of monitoring unless other arrangements are made with the BLM. These stipulations must be attached to the report.
- NO B. The grantee must select one of the following alternatives:
 - 1. Controlled test excavations to determine if cultural resources are present;
 - 2. Reduction of the project size to avoid all significant cultural materials;
 - _____ 3. Relocation of the project;
 - 4. Preparation and implementation of a data recovery plan for cultural sites(s)

YES C. SITE BARRIER/FENCING:

- <u>YES</u> 1. A temporary site protection barrier shall be erected under the direction of the monitoring archaeologist prior to <u>any and all</u> construction. The barrier shall, at a minimum, consist of upright wooden survey lath spaced no more than ten (10) feet apart and marked with blue ribbon flagging or blue paint. There shall be no construction activities or vehicular traffic past the barrier. The barrier shall remain in place through reclamation and reseeding.
