Dear Mr. Cowan or to Whom It May Concern,

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("NMOCD") approved the Lucy 'ALC' State # 8 (Lucy # 8) on August 17, 2006. The approval for the application was due (in part) with Yates Petroleum Corporation and Pogo Producing Company's agreement with Mississippi Potash Company effective June 16, 2000.

However, please note that this well location is in the same area as to where Intrepid Potash NM, LLC (Intrepid) formally Mississippi Potash Company, wrote your company a letter of objection on the Jacque "AQJ' State well applications to drill. (Please refer to my letter dated to you on August 29, 2006 for further explanation.)

Additionally as Yates Petroleum Corporation should be aware, the Lucy well location is in the LMR of Intrepid's potash reserves.

Finally, I have sent e-mails to your company inquiring that a waiver from Intrepid would be needed for the location of the Lucy # 8 well. This is due in part to the above circumstances.

As of this date, the NMOCD has not received a waiver for the Lucy # 8 from Intrepid or a copy of such a letter from Yates Petroleum Corporation.

Therefore until this matter can be resolved, the NMOCD withdraws the above application to drill as noted above in bold type.
