This plan is submitted with Form 3160-3, Application for Permit to Drill, covering the above described well. The purpose of this plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of the surface disturbance involved and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operations, so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effect associated with the operations.

#### 1. **EXISTING ROADS:**

Exhibit A is a portion of the BLM map showing the well and roads in the vicinity of the proposed location. The proposed wellsite is located approximately 36 miles east of Malaga, New Mexico and the access route to the location is indicated in red and green on Exhibit A.

## **DIRECTIONS:**

Go east of Carlsbad on Highway 62-180 to State Road 31. Turn south on 31 and go to Highway 128 (Jal Highway). Turn left on HWY 128 and go approximately 4 miles to Rawhide Road (CR-793) Mississippi Potash Mine Shaft #5 is here. Turn south here on CR-793 and go approx. 3.4 miles. Follow County road to the left and go east for approx. .2 of a mile. Turn south on county road and follow it for approx. 5.4 miles. Turn west on lease road and go approx. .5 of a mile to Bass' Poker Lake Unit #215 well location. . The new road will start here going to the west for approx. 1.1 miles to the southeast corner of the well location.

#### 2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD.

- The proposed new access will be approximately 1.1 miles in length going west to the Α. southeast corner of the drilling pad. The road will lie in a westerly direction.
- B. The new road will be 14 feet in width (driving surface) and will be adequately drained to control runoff and soil erosion.

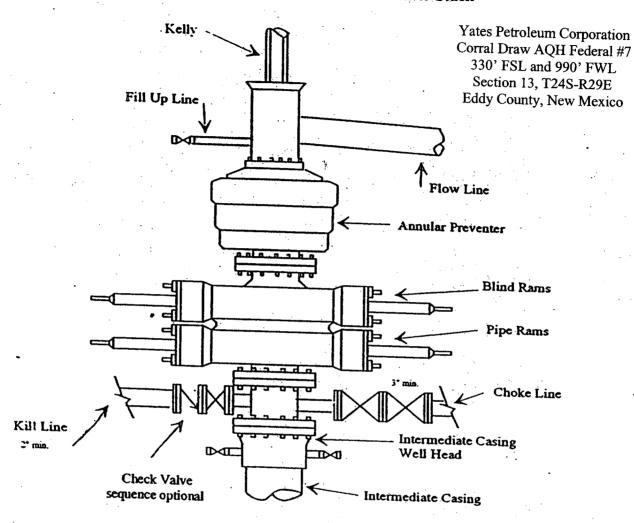

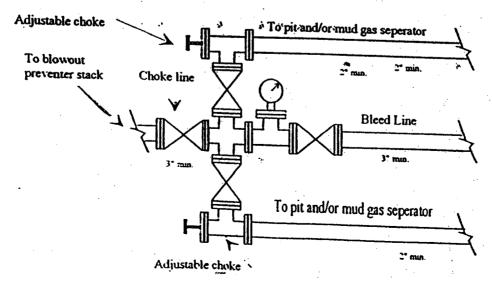


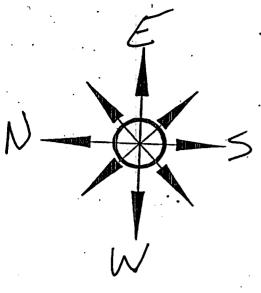

# Typical 3,000 psi choke manifold assembly with at least these minimum features

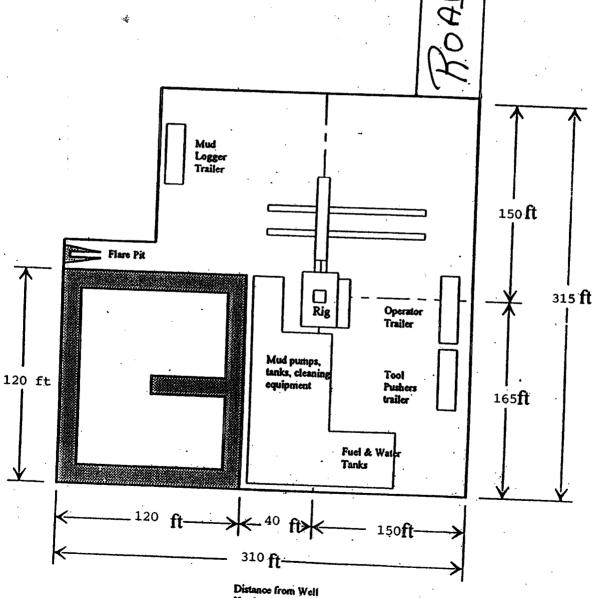

### I. DRILLING OPERATIONS REQUIREMENTS:

1. The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) is to be notified at the Roswell Field Office, 2909 West Second St., Roswell, NM 88201, (505) 627-0272 for wells in Chaves and Roosevelt Counties; the Carlsbad Field Office, 620 East Greene St., Carlsbad, NM 88220, (505) 361-2822 for wells in Eddy County; and the Hobbs Field Station, 414 West Taylor, Hobbs NM 88240, (505) 393-3612 for wells in Lea County, in sufficient time for a representative to witness:

- A. Spudding
- B. Cementing casing: 13 1/2 inch; 8 1/2 inch; 5 1/2 inch.
- C. BOP Tests
- 2. A Hydrogen Sulfide (H2S) Drilling Plan is not required for this well bore.
- 3. Unless the production casing has been run and cemented or the well has been properly plugged, the drilling rig shall not be removed from over the hole without prior approval.
- 4. Submit a Sundry Notice (Form 3160-5, one original and five copies) for each casing string, describing the casing and cementing operations. Include pertinent information such as; spud date, hole size, casing (size, weight, grade and thread type), cement (type, quantity and top), water zones and problems or hazards encountered. The Sundry shall be submitted within 15 days of completion of each casing string. The reports may be combined into the same Sundry if they fall within the same 15 day time frame.
- 5. The API No. assigned to the well by NMOCD shall be included on the subsequent report of setting the first casing string.

## II. CASING:

- 1. The 13 % inch shall be set at 500 Feet with cement circulated to the surface. If cement does not circulate to the surface the appropriate BLM office shall be notified and a temperature survey or cement bond log shall be run to verify the top of the cement. Remedial cementing shall be completed prior to drilling out that string.
- 2. The minimum required fill of cement behind the 8 % inch Intermediate casing is to circulate to surface.
- 3. The minimum required fill of cement behind the 5 ½ inch Production casing is to place TOC at least 200 ft above any potential hydrocarbon bearing zones.

## **III. PRESSURE CONTROL:**

1. All BOP systems and related equipment shall comply with well control requirements as described in Onshore Oil and Gas Order No. 2.
