Seely Oil company proposes to recompleate the subject well as follows:

1. Set CIBP @ 4200' w/ 35' cmt on top
2. Run cmt bond log to determine top of cmt.
3. Perforate for squeeze holes above top of cmt.
4. GIH w/ cmt retainer. Set retainer 60' above squeeze holes.
5. Cement w/ 200 sxs Premium Plus. Allow cmt to cure.
6. Run cmt bond log.
7. Perforate from 3504' - 3510' w/ 2 spf.
8. Fracture treat w/ 10,000 gallons & 20,000 lbs. sand.
9. Return well to production.
