Intermediate - 8-5/8" 32# J-55 @ 3900' - cmt to surface

Production 5-1/2" 17# N-80 @ 9200' - TOC @ 4730' by cmt bond log

Cmt retainer @ 7180', sqz'd 150 sxs, left 20' cmt on top in 2003, csg test witnessed by BLM (Stan Mayo).

P&A procedure: 1. Load hole w/ 9.0 lb/gal mud.

2. Cut off and pull 5-1/2" casing @ 4700', spot 100' Class "C" (14.8 lb/gal) cmt plug across stub.

3. Tag cement plug.

4. Set 100' Class "C" cmt plug 3950' to 3850'.

5. Set 100' Class "C" cmt plug 599' to 499'.

6. Spot 10' Class "C" cmt plug 13' to 3'.

7. Cut off casing 3' below GL and install dry hole marker.
