5. Cut & pull appx 2500' 5½" csg. Could not get in casing. Call BLM, got approval and pumped 40 sx @ 2500'. WOC & tag at 2331'. Pull up hole to 1350' and spot 40 sx. WOC. Tag.
6. Set 100' plug 435'-329'. Tag.
7. Set 62' surface plug & install dry hole marker.
