9-19-06 Prepare to retrieve tbq from hole. MIRU latch on to tbq, pull 40 points on tbq, start out of hole with tbq, LD. Pull 112 jts of 2-3/8 tbq 1 mud jt and seat nipple. Back off flange type well head and replace with larkin wellhead. Flange up BOP, secure well. SD.

9-20-06 RIH w/4-1/2 scraper and tbq, circ hole every 30 jts to btm. Tag with 112 jts at 3659'. LD 1 jt, circ hole @ 3,553' and scraper in hole, pumped 80 bbls down hole, retrieved 60 bbls in vacuum truck. POOH, standing back tbq. RIH with tension pkr and 80 jts @ 2,513', test csg pressure up to 400 psi, held good. POOH with tbq and pkr, secure well. SD.
