Enclosed is Form C-104 for the captioned well. Also, per Paul Kautz's request, attached is a laboratory analysis of the unweathered crude oil sampled under pressure from the separator of this well. The gravity is 48.3° API gravity @ 60° F.

Please be advised that we have received approval from the Bureau of Land Management to vent gas from this well for a period of one year. However, we have applied for right-of-way permits with the State of New Mexico and the Bureau of Land Management to lay a pipeline to sell the gas from this well, and if the necessary approvals are obtained, we intend to do so.
