Marathon Oil Company is proposing to temporarily abandon the Walter Lynch No 11. It is Marathon's intent to pull all tubing and set a cast iron plug at aproximatley 3600' from surface. This CIBP would be 50' above the squeezed Queen interval and 210' above the top perforation in the open Grayburg interval.

Marathon is requesting that we be given a TA status of one year for this well in order to give us time to negotiate the sale of the wellbore to Rice Operating. This time interval will give Rice Operating time to evaluate the wellbore for conversion to a disposal well.
