Marathon Oil Company is proposing to temporarily abandon the Walter Lynch No 12 well. Marathon will set a CIBP @ 3600', which is 76' above the existing Queen perforations in this well. The well is currently shut in as it was making only water.

Marathon is requesting that we be given a TA status of one year for this well in order to give us time to negotiate the sale of the wellbore to Rice Operating. This time interval will give Rice Operating time to evaluate the wellbore for conversion to a disposal well.
