Additional Comments <u>Closure workplan for drilling pit</u> The drilling pit contents will be mixed to stiffen the pit contents A encapsulation trench will be excavated and lined with a 12 mil synthetic liner on former drilling pit site Drilling pit contents will then be emplaced into the encapsulation trench A 20 mil synthetic liner will then be placed over the pit contents with a minimum of a 3' over lap of the underlying trench areas The encapsulation trench will then be backfilled to grade using a minimum of 3' of clean soil and like material A one call and 48 hour notice will be provided to the Oil Conservation Division before pit closure actions begin

Dear Mr. Johnson

The Merle State Unit #11 and Taco AUK State #3 are located in rural Lea County, New Mexico are operated by Yates Petroleum Corporation. The C-144s were submitted June 18, 2007 - approved June 27, 2007 and April 19, 2007 approved April 23, 2007 respectively with site rankings of 20 points indicating level to ground water of less than fifty feet. This assessment was based on USGS nearest levels to groundwater to the Merle State Unit #11 and the Taco AUK State #3 locations.

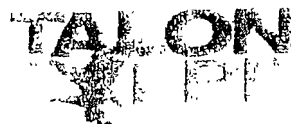
Further assessment has revealed that the locations have site rankings of 10 points which is more than 50 feet but less than 100 feet to groundwater. This was based on the findings on the Merle State Unit #3 after Yates Petroleum Corporation sought the services of Elbert Taylor of Talon LPE to drill a soil boring to a total depth of seventy feet that was left open for 24 hours and tested using a water level indicator and no groundwater was encountered at any point in the entire seventy feet depth boring. Merle State Unit #3 is closer to Merle State Unit #11 and Taco AUK State #3 than the USGS closest location.

Based on this new information, Yates Petroleum Corporation respectfully requests that NMOCD Site Ranking Scores be adjusted from the 20 points to 10 points for closure of the reserve pit at these locations.
