KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT:

WITORE IL, the undersigned authority, a Notary Public in and for said County and State, on this day personally appeared DELMA MADON, well known to me, who, upon oath did depose and say:

I am Production Superintendent for Lan G. McCormick and Associates and I am Vice President and Manager of development and production operations for Santiago Oil & Gas Company, and have personal knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated.

Location for Lan G. McCormick and Associates, - State Lease, Well No. 1-30, was started on September 6, 1938. A cable tool rig was moved in, rigged up and said well was spotted at 3:00 o'clock P. M., September 7, 1938.

At 8:00 o'clock A. M., September 8, 1938, a 13 inch hole had been drilled to a depth of 10 feet in caliche,

At 8:00 o'clock A. M., September 9, 1938, said hole was drilling ahead at 100 feet in red bed.

At 8:00 o'clock A. M., September 10, 1938, said well was drilling ahead in sand at 110 feet.

At 8:00 o'clock A. M., September 11, 1938, said well was drilling ahead in hard sand at 140 feet.

At 8:00 o'clock A. M., September 12, 1938, said well was drilling ahead in sand at 165 feet. Water bearing sand was encountered from 120 feet to 145 feet.

At 8:00 o'clock A. M., September 13, 1938, said well was drilling ahead at 185 feet in sandy shale.

At 8:00 o'clock A. M., September 14, 1938, said well was drilling in sand at 210 feet.

At 8:00 o'clock A. M., September 15, 1938, said well was drilling in red beds at 270 feet.

At 8:00 o'clock A. M., September 16, 1938, said well had been drilled to 280 feet and preparations were being made to run 3 1/8"

casing to catch off water. On September 16, 1938, 203 feet of 13 3/8" casing was set at 280 feet, cemented with 300 sacks of regular cement, cement was circulated and plug was on bottom at 1:00 o'clock P. M., 1900 until September 19, 1938.

At 8:00 o'clock A. M., September 20, 1938, cement plug had been drilled, the casing tested by bailing dry and found o.k., and was drilling ahead in red beds at 289 feet.

At 8:00 A. M., September 21, 1938, said well was drilling ahead in red beds at 294 feet.

At 8:00 o'clock A. M., September 22, 1938, said well was drilling ahead in red beds at 300 feet.

In view of letter by Mr. Ted Bilberry, Supervisor Oil and Gas Division, Commissioner of Public Lands to Pan American Petroleum Corporation, under date of September 18, 1938, operations were temporarily suspended. On October 1, 1938, following Mr. Bilberry's letter to Pan American Petroleum Corporation under date of September 10, 1938, location was cleaned up ready for rotary drilling rig. October 3th and 6th, building derrick, and waiting on rig at 300 feet in red beds.
