

# **WORK PLAN**

## **General:**

On 10/18/07, a valve on the load line at the tank battery was accidentally opened by cattle. Oil from the tank spilled on location and a small amount into the pasture North. All available fluids were picked up and valve repaired. Work has been started to remediate site, per Chris Williams, a C-141 was filed and Work Plan is forthcoming.

## **Groundwater:**

According to the water information, the depth of groundwater occurs at approximately 75 ft.

## **Remediation Proposal:**

All available fluid was picked up or burned up. Our cleanup proposal will be to excavate and haul the contaminated soil to an OCD approved facility. After contaminated soil has been removed, the area will be sampled for final cleanup, and only after OCD approval, we will backfill, level and seed. Hungry Horse Services will be doing the excavation.

## **Ranking Criteria Score - 10**

This site has a 1000 ppm cleanup level. Area will be tested for TPH and Chloride per OCD.
