

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Americo's State T battery had an upset and sent a slug of oil into the disposal system causing the skim oil tank to overflow.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

All oil stayed inside the firewall and on top of old spill site. Entire spill site is to be remediated as soon as partners approve work. We are also investigating adding an additional skim oil tank as an emergency backup to catch these occasional slugs of oil.
