On September 26, 2007, we completed a field examination on the plugged Jack B-27 #3 well located 1980' FSL and 330' FEL, Section 27, T24S, R37E in Lea County, New Mexico. 43 CFR 3162.5-1 (b) states "Upon conclusion of operations, the operator shall reclaim the disturbed surface in a manner approved or reasonably prescribed by the authorized officer."

After monitoring vegetation growth at the above well location for several years, adequate and desirable native coverage has failed to grow over much of the reserve pit area. Please submit a reclamation plan for the reserve pit. This may include deep burial, complete removal of contents, or capping (topping with two feet of caliche and one foot of native soils).

Please submit the reclamation plan for the reserve pit to Jenny Bell at the above address or fax (505-885-9264) no later than November 7, 2007. Do not initiate reclamation activities until you have been contacted by an authorized official regarding the proposal. Failure to comply with this written order will result in a Notice of Incidents of Noncompliance.

Under provisions of 43 CFR 3165.3, you may request an Administrative Review of the order described above. Such request, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20 business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management, Post Office Box 27115, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87502-0115. Such request shall not result in a suspension of the order unless the reviewing official so determines. Procedures governing appeals from the instructions, orders, or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR Part 4.
