Ladies and Gentlemen:

On December 20, 2007, Bureau of Land Management (BLM) completed a field examination of the abandoned Meyer B-4 No. 25, located 2180' FSL and 1980' FWL in Section 4, T. 21 S., R. 36 E., Lea County, New Mexico.

All final abandonment requirements have been met except for vegetative growth (20%) established evenly across the location. BLM will continue to monitor the surface restoration of this abandoned well site. All final abandonment requirements will have been met when BLM is confident that the disturbed surfaces are capable of being restored to a condition similar to their original state.
