On September 12, 2007, we completed a field examination on the plugged Jack Tank 7 Federal #2 well located 330' FNL and 660' FEL, Section 7, T24S, R32E in Lea County, New Mexico. 43 CFR 3162.5-1 (b) states "Upon conclusion of operations, the operator shall reclaim the disturbed surface in a manner approved or reasonably prescribed by the authorized officer."

After monitoring vegetation growth at the above well location for several years, adequate and desirable native coverage has failed to grow. There is low vegetation growth over the reserve pit, in particular. Salts have leached and plastics are visible on the surface. Please submit a reclamation plan for the reserve pit. This may include deep burial, complete removal of contents, or capping (topping with two feet of caliche and one foot of native soils). If capping is the preferred method, caliche can be scraped over the pit from the well pad and access road (see below).

Caliche should be removed from the access road and well pad. Caliche can be utilized on other well pads, roads, or in the capping of the aforementioned reserve pit. Please rip and seed all disturbed locations with LPC seed mixture (see enclosed information).

Rebarricade the access road to discourage vehicular traffic.

Please submit the reclamation plan for the reserve pit to Jenny Bell at the above address or fax (505-885-9264) no later than October 23, 2007. Do not initiate reclamation activities until you have been contacted by an authorized official regarding the proposal. Failure to comply with this written order will result in a Notice of Incidents of Noncompliance.

Under provisions of 43 CFR 3165.3, you may request an Administrative Review of the order described above. Such request, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20 business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management, Post Office Box 27115, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87502-0115.

Such request shall not result in a suspension of the order unless the reviewing official so determines. Procedures governing appeals from the instructions, orders, or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR Part 4.
