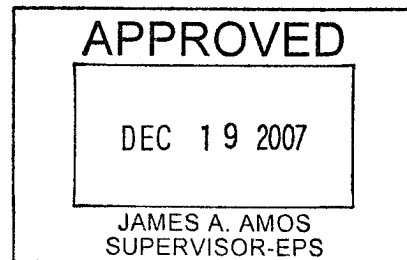


Ladies and Gentlemen:
