The completion C-105 was submitted to the Oil Conservation Division on 7-11-07 and scanned onto their system in July, 2007 (copy attached). We will prepare and submit the Bureau of Land Management Form 3160-4 to the Carlsbad, New Mexico BLM office. First Production on this well was 6-21-07.
