SITE INSPECTION

Dear Operator:

On May 13, 2008, Oil Conservation Division (OCD) inspector Mark Whitaker made an inspection of your State Vacuum Unit and noted the following items that failed to meet standards of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.

Signs on existing wells were not legible and did not include all the information as required by Rule 103. Each sign shall show the (1) name of operator, (2) name of property, (3) well number, (4) location by footage, (5) quarter-quarter or unit letter, (6) section, (7) township, (8) range, and (9) API number.

The T/A status of State Vacuum Unit Well No. 10 has expired.

As a result of these findings, you will be required to replace all signs to include the current requirements as stipulated under Rule 19.15.3.103. A re-inspection will be conducted in 90 days to verify compliance.

In addition, a C-103 should be submitted before July 1, 2008, detailing your intent to T/A, Plug, or return the No.10 to production.
